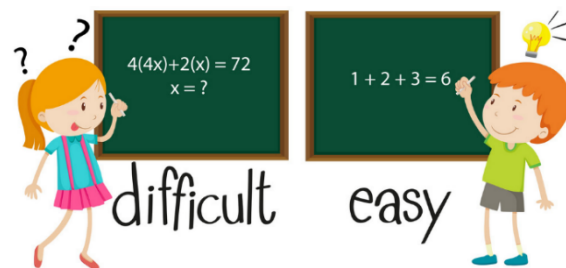

We all find some things easy and some things hard.

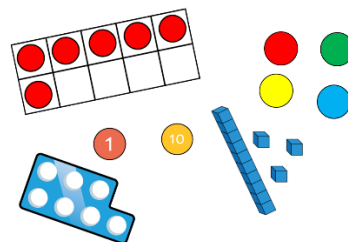


Some children find learning really difficult.

**Mrs Botwright is our SENDCo. She can help teachers and TAs work out the extra support that children need to make learning easier for them.**

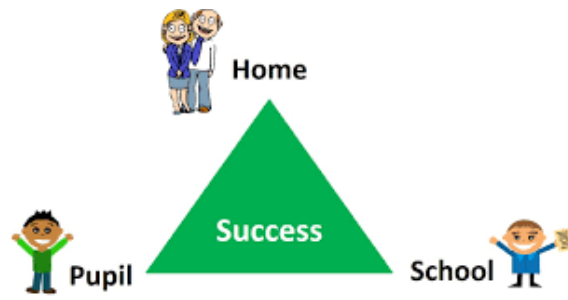


**Mrs Botwright - SENDCo**
