Message from Mr Carlyle

We began this week in school with World Kindness Day, which led very nicely into anti-bullying week. One of the features of our school community that I think says a lot about who we are is the way that small acts of kindness get dropped into our school life every day, in lots of different ways. They come from a variety of sources; children, adults, parents, the wider community that we are a part of. The poet Brian Bilston describes the 'symptoms' of kindness as including 'tear drops, sudden laughter, a feeling of warmth, and a peculiar uplifting of the heart'. This completely fits with the values that are central to Harleston Sancroft Academy, across both phases and has been seen in abundance this week.

On Sunday I was privileged to be part of the Harleston remembrance service in the town. It is very humbling to be still and quiet and reflective and remember those who have given so much in conflicts around the world. Yoga will be in the Music Hub - Collect KS2 playground.









Year 2
