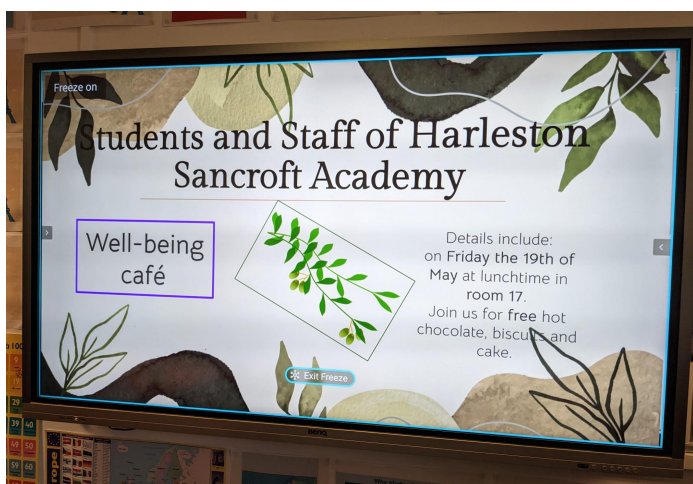
Our Vision
