Spray of martins, Proust's fountain

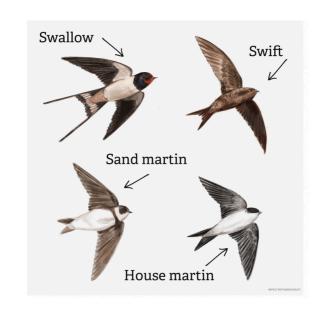
Of small birds, whose light shadows
