

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY OPPORTUNITIES

Head Students: Work within, and lead, the student leadership team. Meet, feedback and contribute to the Senior Leadership Team to raise standards in and out of the classroom. Lead assemblies. Fulfil duties in and out of school as required by staff SLT. Oversee the student duta rota system.

SSLT: the Student Senior Leadership Team perform duties as directed to raise standards in and out of the classroom. Oversee student leaders on their duty day.

House Captains: Perform duties as directed by SLT/HoY11. Support the Head Students and the prefect system. Represent and organise Inter-House events, including charity days and within whole school activities and events.

Sports Captains: Organise house teams to represent their house. Organise one whole school sporting event in conjunction with the other Sports Captains. Be involved in all sporting activities and events. Support the primary school sports days and events as required.

Senior Prefects: Involved in whole school activities and events. Work with the perfect team to organise charity events.











Mental Health leaders: They organise mental health and well-being activities and events for all students.

Student Ambassadors: Students are appointed to support the transition programme, working with the Year 5 and 6 children.

School Council: A representative from each form group attends regular meetings. The School Council plan and implement a number of changes across the community, i.e. uniform reviews.

Peace Project: Student representatives work alongside The Rotary Club to follow a programme looking at how to role model and encourage peace within themselves, their school, their community and then further afield.

Diversity Group: A group of students meet weekly to support our community by providing a space for discussions and support around equal opportunity, regardless of age, gender, sexual orientation, race, colour, religion or disability. The leaders feedback to SLT as necessary to ensure everyone has a voice.
