Last Sunday, the 105th anniversary of the Armistice marked the end of the fighting in the First World War, but it wasn't until 28th June 1919 that Germany and the Allied Nations (including Britain, France, Italy and Russia) signed the Treaty of Versailles, formally ending the war.
