We know that anyone can find themselves at crisis point for a number of different reasons.



'Waveney Foodbank' works using a voucher referral system which can be obtained from a variety of different agencies, including Citizens Advice, children's centres and health visitors, who will take some basic details for you. Once you have been issued with a voucher, you can exchange this for a minimum of three days of emergency food at your nearest foodbank centre.

We are pleased to inform parents and carers that we are now able to support our families by issuing vouchers. Please speak to Mr Mullen (primary phase), or **Miss Booty** (secondary phase) if you would require a voucher.
